Rock UK Residential Visit: Monday 17th June - Wednesday 19th June 2019

Following the success of previous residential visits to Rock UK Frontier Centre, we have planned a return visit for students to enjoy the activities and challenges available and experience an adventure that students will remember forever. The Rock UK Centre is based in Irthlingborough, Wellingborough and the trip will take place from Monday 17th June to Wednesday 19th June 2019.

The residential visit, which is a three day and two night experience, will be fully catered and a full programme of activities will be available for the students to try out whilst they are there. As soon as we have numbers confirmed we will be able to advise exactly which activities we will be tackling on the trip.

WHAT WE DO


