Shakespeare Schools Festival Performance – Thursday 22nd November 2018

As you know, once again our school is taking part in the Shakespeare Schools Festival (SSF) 2018 and your child has been taking part in rehearsals and a half day workshop. We are now nearing the performance date of Thursday 22nd November 2018, when a final rehearsal is planned followed by the 30-minute performance of *A Midsummer Night's Dream* at *The Key Theatre*, Peterborough.

On the day of the performance, we will leave school straight after lunch and travel in our school minibus, arriving at the theatre at 1.30pm. We will then spend the afternoon with SSF staff, who will lead the company in a technical and dress rehearsal, ensuring everyone feels ready and supported for the evening to come. Then, in a celebratory finale to our festival journey, the company will join other local schools as the students take to the stage and share their hard work and success with you and the local community.
