## Spring Term Newsletter - Term 1

We've had a really great start to our Spring Term and students have settled back really well into the routine of school life after the Christmas break.

We'd like to give you an update on what we've been up to during the last few weeks, as well as what we have planned for the second part of the Spring Term and we'd like to start with a few "wow" moments that we've had in Secondary Phase and Primary Phase.

## **Hilltop Residential**

At the beginning of February, several of our secondary students and staff all enjoyed a fantastic three days at Hilltop Outdoor Centre in Norfolk, on the first residential of the year. Despite the weather being a bit damp and cold, 26 secondary pupils and 10 staff all took part in numerous activities and had a fantastic time.

## Alice In Wonderland

On Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> February The 'Mad Hatters Tea party' was held in primary phase, hosted by Dragonfly Class, Mrs Pembery and Ms Seccombe and pupils who go to story club.

In preparation, the children had made top hats and they had been to charity shops to source fine china tea cups, saucers and tea pots.

Both Mrs Ydlibi and Mrs Ives were seated at a table that was set out, and decorated like something from a film set, with many props and characters from the story. The planning and resulting outcomes of this activity were extremely impressive. The children had been taught to use soft conversational voices, remain seated, pour tea, serve cakes from cake stands and drink from tea cups (straight backs and an extended little finger as one does!) They chatted with humour and with conversation that would put many a mainstream children's party to shame.

It was a most civilised affair. Children will remember this event and can begin to demonstrate these skills in other settings. This was a very proud moment for us to experience. The children were a delight and have risen to high expectations, demonstrating their developing levels of oracy through the story stimulus 'Alice in Wonderland'.

## **Young Writers Competition**

Some of our Hawk class pupils took part in a Young Writers competition entitled "Spooky Sagas" which was launched to inspire pupils aged 7-11. Pupils from all schools, mainstream and special, were challenged to use their writing powers to create a mini saga in just 100 words, to write a spine-tingling tale that used atmosphere and suspense, from things that go bump in the night to Halloween pranks.

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Entries were submitted and the Young Writers team reviewed them all, choosing the best to be published in a book. We are absolutely delighted to confirm that two of our pupils' entries, Renato and Oliver, have been selected to be published in "Spooky Sagas – Cambridgeshire" and would like to congratulate them on this fantastic achievement – we can't wait to see the publication!

# **Visiting Artist**

At Christmas we welcomed back the fantastic mixed media and movement artist, Usha Mahenthiralingham, to work on a Saxon themed project with our students. Usha came into the school for several dates throughout December and, this week, will be coming back to school to put the finishing touches to the piece, with the help of students.
