## **Topic: Potions**

By reading George's Marvellous Medicine, we'll learn all about mysterious potions, and write a safety label for George's bottle. We'll sort everyday items into solids, liquids and gases. Using our investigation skills we'll explore capacity and the properties of liquids. We'll also design fabulous bottles for magical potions. Becoming super scientists, we'll investigate chemical reactions and states of matter. We'll write spells with magical, strange or gruesome effects - what ingredients will we use? It will be great fun to make chocolate hearts and bath bombs! We'll also create canvas art on a large scale!

### **Foundation Subjects**

In Science we will be developing scientific questioning on the topic of solids, liquids and gases, and investigating how and why some materials change their state

In Understanding of the World and Humanities we will be exploring the history of medicine and potions throughout the world.

In Art we will be designing our own potion bottles, create some colourful canvases and studying a sequence of love/love potion inspired paintings.

In Design & Technology we will be making bath bombs, chocolate hearts and ice cream/ice lollies.

In RE we will be talking about our faiths and beliefs including atheism, Judaism, Islam, Hinduism, Sikhi, Buddhism, Christianity and Humanism.

In PSHEE we will be looking at citizenship, health and safety in the community and risk in the community.
