

Pupil Premium Spend and Impact Statement 2018-19

Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) 2018-2019 provides funding to:

- Raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap with their peers; and
- Support children and young people with parents in the regular armed forces

The PPG per pupil for 2018-2019 is as follows:

As in previous years this funding is in addition to the school's budget and represents a major investment in pupils.

During the current academic year 2018-19 Medeshamstede Academy received £56,264. These funds were used to raise attainment for disadvantaged pupils (see breakdown below). This aim of the spend was to secure the best possible outcomes for the pupils to whom it is awarded.
